

Salt Dough Ornaments

SUPPLIES

- •Glue gun
- Template
- Scissors
- •1 C Flour
- •1/4 C Salt
- String
- Paint brush
- Paints
- •Spoon
- •Big Bowl
- Plastic Wrap

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Gather all of your supplies.
- 2. Dump the flour and salt into a big bowl.



3. Add 1/3 C of water and mix, mix, mix. If the dough is a bit dry, add a few tablespoons of water.



4. Dump out the dough onto a clean counter and knead it with your hands until it's nice and smooth.



- 5. Set the dough to the side.
- 6. Cut out one of the long strips on your template page and tape the ends together to make a circle.



7. Using hot glue, fill in the shape of one of the templates. Do at least 2 layers so the glue is nice and thick.



8. Glue the strip onto the circle. Place the plastic wrap over the circle. Pull off a small chunk of dough and press it onto the hot glue and inside the circle.



9. Lift up the plastic wrap, or flip over the paper exposing your finished ornament!



- 10. Using your straw, push a hole through the top of your ornament for a string to go through.
- 11. Place the dough ornament onto the black cooking sheet and place in an oven preheated to 200°F for 2 hours.



- 12. Let the ornament(s) cool and use the included paint to decorate your ornaments.
- 13. You can attach all of the ornaments to one string to make a garland, or cut the string into pieces and hang them individually on your tree!
